Scope.

This Environmental Management Plan has been adopted to continue SES Engineering (Newark) Ltd commitment to the environment and at the same time provide the necessary controls to ensure compliance with environmental legislation. The Environmental Procedures encompassed by this Management Plan will pro-actively cover all aspects and environmental impact of SES Engineering (Newark) Ltds activities, and will deliver a comprehensive, workable, and auditable Management System for environmental protection throughout.

Responsibilities.
